**2. Updates from Chair**

**3. Presentation from Tadarrayl Starke, Associate Vice Provost for Student Success**

- a. The underrepresented student probation rate decreased fall 2022 compared to previous terms, but there is still concern for underrepresented and underserved populations.
- b. 40-41% of Black students and 24% of Latinx students are on probation at the end of their first term in college.
- c. Only 8.3% of students who were on probation in their first term eventually graduated.
- d. Many students feel hesitant to engage with advisors.
- e. Course redesign and cultural competency are areas the office is looking into.
