## Agenda:

1. Approval of Minutes: due to a lack of quorum, minutes were tabled to be approved at the next meeting.

2. Enrollment Updates from Student Life & Enrollment (Mona Lucas): Mona Lucas shared updates on undergraduate admissions processing for the Fall 2026 enrollment class, stating that their office is confident that there will be a strong incoming class, **albeit slightly smaller than this year's class**. Mona Lucas added that they have created a **new scholarship program specific to regional campus students**. Mona Lucas also shared information about the renewal criteria for merit scholarships, stating that in addition to meeting the Satisfactory Academic Progress requirement, students must also meet a minimum 2.5 GPA (3.0 for full-ride awards, Day of Pride, Nutmeg and Stamps).
3. Honors at Regional Campuses (Kaitlin Heenehan): Kaitlin Heenehan shared a PowerPoint presentation highlighting the ways in which honors and enrichment programs were established and currently operate on the regional campuses. Kaitlin Heenehan also shared how the program has grown on each regional campus over the years, with a total of **2409 honors students across all campuses (including Storrs); Avery Point (4); Hartford (41); Stamford (101); Waterbury (15)**. The presentation also highlighted how the availability of these programs across all campuses has streamlined resources, support and access for students, having a positive impact on retention and student satisfaction. The floor was opened to questions and discussion ensued.
4. The March Enrollment Committee meeting was rescheduled for Thursday, March 26<sup>th</sup> as the original meeting date overlapped with Spring break.
