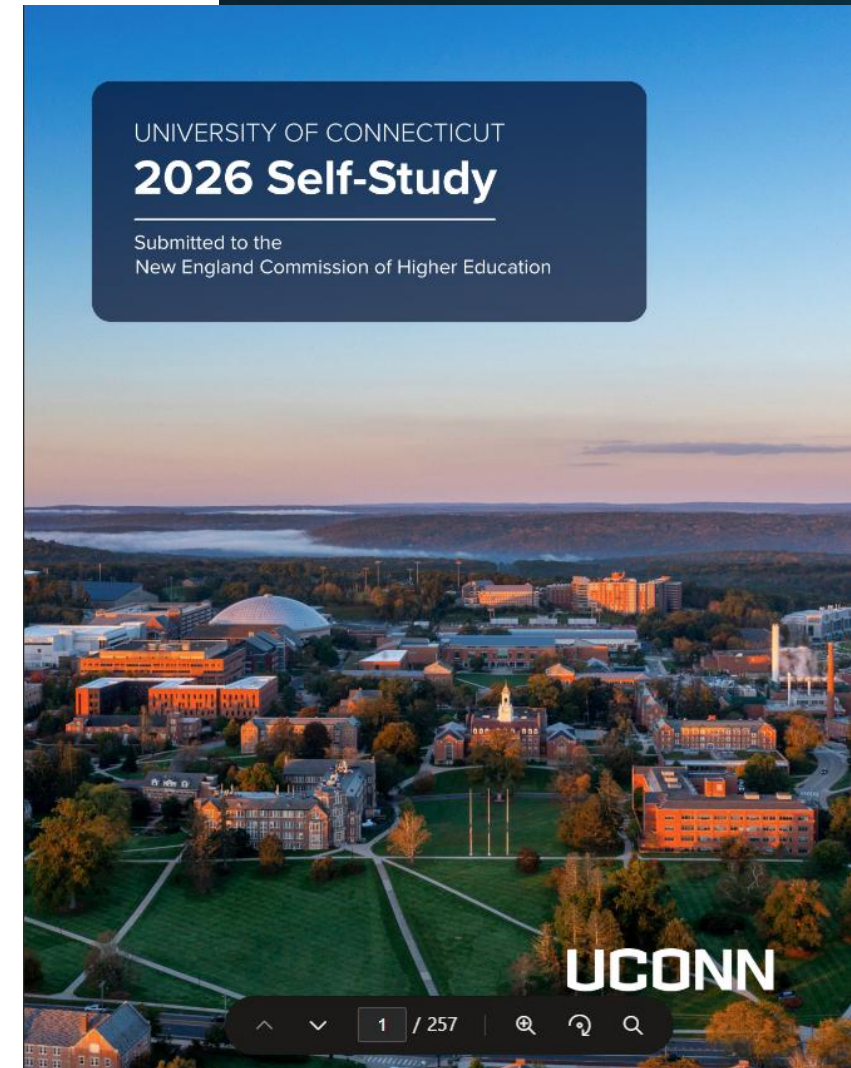


UConn Self-Study and NECHE 2026 Evaluation Information
